SCIENTISTS DISCOVER A WORRYING DECREASE OF KING PENGUIN POPULATION ON A REMOTE ISLAND DUE TO GLOBAL WARMING

The largest colony of king penguins in the world has sadly decreased by nearly 90% in around 35 years according to worried researchers.

The world's largest colony of king penguins is located in France's remote lie aux Cochons—just between the top of Africa and Antarctica—the island used to be crowded by two million king penguins. Sadly, recent photos taken by satellites and helicopters have shown us that the population of these amazing animats have indeed collapsed, according to a study published in Arctic Science, it is said that around only 200,000 king penguins remain in the colony. This Colony of penguins represented nearly one-third of the king penguins in the world. The Scientists are unsure of what exactly caused such a dramatic decline but they have several ideas.





Studies have shown that global warming, pollution and overfishing in the Antarctic could force the king penguins to disappear by the end of the century. The report, published in the journal Nature Climate Change, found that as global warming transforms the environment in the world's last great wilderness 70% of king penguins could either disappear or be forced to find new breeding grounds.


King penguins—the second largest type of penguin—only breed on specific isolated islands in the Southern Ocean where there is no ice cover and easy access to the sea.

If king penguins were to become extinct, this would affect all of their predators including: Killer Whales, Leopard Seals and the Southern Giant Petrel.

 This could upset the food chain and put some species in danger of extinction.
- Extreme weather—Some scientists think that warming will fuel more powerful hurricanes as well as more droughts and flooding in different areas of the world.



FLORENCE ZIMMERMAN'S FAMOUS CHOC CHIP COOKLES

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 cup caster sugar 1tsp of baking powder
- A pinch of salt 2 cups plain flour
- 1 cup of butter melted . 1tsp vanilla extract
 - 200g chocolate chips

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. First preheat your oven to 160 degrees Celsius.
- 2. Now it's time to melt the butter. We find it easiest to do this in the microwave but keep an eye on it. this usually only takes about 30 seconds.
- 2. Add the sugar and melted butter into a bowl and stir.
- 3. Sift the plain flour then add baking powder. vanilla and salt into a separate bowl and mix.
- 4. Wash your hands as they are now going to become your mixers. Add the sugar and butter mixture and the chocolate chips to your flour mixture and knead until your mixture resembles cookie dough. Now add the egg and continue to knead with your hands.
- 5. Your dough is now complete and ready for you to make your cookies. To do this separate into approx, one tablespoon sizes, roll these into a ball and then flatten a little and pop them on your baking tray. Make sure you either grease your baking tray with butter or use baking paper to stop the cookies sticking. Leave at least 5cm between your cookies as they will spread out whilst baking.
- 6. The last step is to pop these delicious little morsels into your preheated over for ten minutes, the baking time will vary slightly depending on the size of your cookies and on how hard or gooey you like your cookies to be!





WARNING: Always ask an adult to help when baking with heat.

RAINFORESTS

Tropical Rainforests are forests with tall trees, warm climates and a lot of rain! They are important to us as the plants of the rainforest generate much of the Earth's oxygen as well as being home to as many as 30 million species of plants and animals!

Rainforests are found in Australia, Asia, Africa and Central and South America. The largest rainforest in the world is the Amazon rainforest located in South America.







WHERE ARE RAINFORESTS LOCATED?

Rainforests are located in the tropics, the region between the Tropic of Cancer and the Tropic of Capricorn, tropical rainforests are found close to the Equator. In this tropic zone the sun is very powerful and shines the same amount of time every day all year long, keeping the climate warm and stable.

Many countries have tropical rainforests, the countries with the largest areas of tropical forest include: Brazil, Congo, Peru, Indonesia and Colombia.

THE FOUR DIFFERENT LAYERS OF A RAINFOREST:

EMERGENT LAYER: This is the very top if the rainforest, only the tallest trees reach this level, some of these trees can be up to 81 meters high, now that's a tree we wouldn't want to fall from! The emergent layer is home to birds, butterflies, small monkeys, snakes and bugs.

CANOPY LAYER: This is the layer of branches and leaves formed by closely spaced rainforest trees. Most of the plants and animals in the rainforest live in the canopy there are also plants that grow in the canopy layer. He in roots don't reach the ground which is why they are called air plants. The canopy layer is home to frogs, sloths, lizards and snakes as well as many insects.





UNDERSTORY LAYER: This layer consists of many vines, thick vegetation and not much sunlight. The Understory layer is home to birds, butterflies, frogs and snake

There are two types of



FOREST FLOOR: This layer is dark, damp and filled with many dead leaves, twigs and plants. The forest floor is dark because of the trees above stopping the sunlight from shining through. It is said that only 2% of the rainforests sunlight reaches the forest floor. The Forrest floor is home to many animals such as Jaguars in South America, Gorillas and Leopards in Africa and Tigers, Elephants and Tapirs in Asia.

Always make sure that what you post online is appropriate & regularly check your security settings to make sure that everything you post can only be seen by your trusted close friends & family. If you don't know how to do that, you can ask an adult for help.

CATFISHING

It's important to be aware of "catfishing." Catfishing is when a person sets up a profile & pretends to be someone that they're not. You might think you're talking to another kid your age, but it could be an adult pretending to be someone your age behind a computer screen. Always be careful when someone you don't know approaches you on social media, il something about it makes you feel uncomfortable, you should tell an adult or teacher as soon as possible. 






ANIMAL PREDATOR

WHAT IS A PREDATOR?

A predator is an animal that eats other animals, and the prey is the animal that gets eaten by the predator. Predators are wild animals that hunt and prev on other animals. All animals need to live but predator animals need the flesh of the animals that they kill to be able to survive in the wild.

Predators are carnivores, meaning their diet consists of meat. Some predators. such as bears are also scavengers, this means they will eat the carcasses of animals that they didn't hunt themselves. They're not the bad guys! They are simply just animals trying to find food to survive and feed their young

WHERE DO PREDATORS LIVE?

Predators can be found on any continent of the world. Hot desert climates, and lakes. Predators are found in nearly every habitat known to us.



CAN AN ANIMAL BE BOTH A PREDATOR AND A PREY?

Yes, an animals can be both a predator and prev. For example: A frog is a predator when it eats an insect. If a hawk eats the frog, it becomes prev.

APEX PREDATORS

An apex predator is an alpha predator that is at the top of the food chain with no natural predators. This means no other animals in their ecosystem can prev on them

THE POLAR BEAR: These mighty animals are the largest land carnivores on earth. They have the best sense of smell in the entire animal kingdom and when standing, can reach more than 3 meters high.

THE GREAT WHITE SHARK: With roughly 300 sharp teeth and a deadly sense of smell capable of detecting tiny amounts of bloody from 5 kilometres away the Great White is one of the deadliest predators of the sea.

THE GREY WOLF: These creatures may look cute, but they are far from your loveable pet! Wolves are the largest member of the dog family and like to hunt mostly at night in packs of 6-10 wolves.



THE ALASKAN BROWN BEAR: Although their diet mainly consists of salmon, this grizzly bear weighs a huge 680 kilograms. Human or animal, if anyone gets between a mother and her baby cubs they will have a problem. With knife-life claws, an amazing sense of hearing and smell you wouldn't want to go on a hike in the wilderness alone!

BIRDS OF PREY

Birds of prey are predators, meaning that they hunt other animals such as mice, insects and other rodents. Birds of prey are also known as raptors, this word comes from the Latin word 'rapere' meaning' to capture'. Birds of prey are usually large and strong birds with sharp claws that help them scoop up their prey as they swoop down. Their great eyesight helps them to see their prey from far away. There are hundreds of birds that fall into the birds of prey category however, the major kinds of birds of prey include. Owls, Eagles, Hawks and Falcons. Let's take a closer look at the types of birds of prey and their characteristics.



HAWKS

Out of all of the birds of prey, the hawk is the most common. You may have heard their screeching, echoing call or have seen them soaring high in the skyl Hawks commonly place their nests on top of cliffs, or tall trees, these hawk made nests that can be up to 90cm wide. That's a big enough nest for a human to sit in! Hawks have long, broad wings and short wide tails and are often spotted soaring over open fields.

A hawks diet usually consists of small mammals including rodents and rabbits. They also eat birds, reptiles, fish and insects









OWLS

If you have ever seen this nocturnal animal before, you would know that the owl has notably large eyes, a large flat face and lowes to make a "hoot" sound. Owls can be found in all different types of habitats, and every continent except Antarctica contains species of owls. Owls are found in many places including deserts, forests and mountains.

Most owls like to eat insects, small mammals like mice and rabbits and other smaller birds. Owls cannot actually chew their food because they do not have teeth. They use their beak to tear apart their food and eat it.

BALD EAGLE

The Bald Eagle is a very large raptor with a dark brown body and wings and a white head and tail. Their legs and feet are bright yellow along with its eyes and large hooked bill. They have a wingspan of up to 2 metres wide! Eagles can fly up to 48km per hour and can dive at speeds up to 160km per hour.

Bald eagles feed on live fish that they snatch out of the water using their sharp beaks. They also feed on dead spawned salmon along the stream banks. Bald eagles also eat ducks and other birds along with small animals such as mice and rabbits.







FALCON

Just like a speeding bullet, the falcon attacks and snatches their prey in mid-air! Most of a falcon's diet consists of other birds! But falcons aren't picky, and will eat all sorts of other creatures, including lizards, rodents, even bats. A falcon also uses its amazing eyesight for hunting and has an incredible driving speed. As the falcon performed, and we, it soars to an extreme height, then dives at a speed up to 323km per hour! While diving, the falcon is the fastest animal on Earth.



ENDANGERED SPEC

Many of the living animals in the world today are endangered, this means they are at risk of becoming extinct on Earth. Endangered animals include Giant Pandas, Tigers, Turtles, Orangutans and countless more animals. Their numbers have been dramatically reduced and only a few remain in the wild.

How do animals become endangered? The biggest threats to these beautiful creatures come from humans. People are destroying animals' habitats including rainforests.









As new buildings, farms and palm oil plantations are replacing these rainforests, it leaves less room for wild animals resulting in a shortage of food and a safe place for them to raise their young.

This causes the amount of reproduction to drop. Many animals are also hunted by humans for their fur or their horns. Other animals are sadly killed by pollution and global warming, this affects the climate resulting in the animal's survival rates.

GIANT PANDA: Native to the mountain forests of China, the Giant Panda is one of the most endangered and beloved species in the world today. With only 2060 Pandas living in the wild, The Giant Panda is considered endangered as Pandas reproduce very rarely. The main reason that the Panda population has declined is because of habitat destruction.

TIGER: The Tiger, commonly referred to "The King Of The Jungle" has been hunted for century's for its unique patterned fur. Three of the nine Tiger subspecies are already extinct. Less than 500 of these Tigers exist today.





AMUR LEOPARD: it is said that less than 70 Amur Leopards exist today. The beautiful creature is Critically Endangered as it has been commonly hunted and killed for its fur.



GORILLAS: Cross River Gorillas & Mountain Gorillas are both classified as Critically Endangered - that is two out of the five Gorilla subspecies. There are only 200-300 Cross River Gorillas left in the wild SEA TURITE: Two types of Sea Turtles are amongst the most endangered species in the world: the Hawksbill Turtle and the Leatherback Turtle



SUMATRAN ELEPHANT: in the last 25 years, the Sumatran Elephant has lost a devastating 70% of its habitat to deforestation for palm oil plantations. Less than 2000 are said to exist.





ORANGUTAN: 80% of the Orangutans population has been lost in the past 75 years mainly because of mass deforestation.

WHAT YOU CAN DO TO HELP:

Never purchase products made from threatened or endangered species. Overseas holidays can be exciting and super fun, its common to buy souvenirs. But sometimes the souvenirs are made from species that are close to extinction. Avoid supporting the market in illegal wildlife including tortoise-shell, lyory and coral

Recycle and buy sustainable products. Buy recycled paper. Never buy furniture made from wood from rainforests. Recycle your mobile phones, because a mineral used in our mobile phones and other electronics is mined in gorilla habitat. Minimize your use of palm oil because forests where tigers live are being cut down to plant balm plantations.

Raise money and donate to an animal fund



You can easily get involved and hold a sausage sizzle, start a lemonade stand or ask your local milk bar if you can set up a can to collect donations for a specific animal fund.

WHAT IS A DROUGHT?

Drought is a natural event caused by the absence of water for a long period of time, at a place where it is considered 'not normal' compared to its usual conditions. Some places have lots of fresh water such as rivers, lakes, lagoons, ponds etc. which are constantly filled by rainfall, runoffs and water from underground. Others places too are known to have very little water. Droughts become a big issue when they begin to affect water supply for irrigation, municipal, industrial, energy, and ecosystem function.

> Drought is a period of time where as a result of dry weather, there is not enough water where there usually is to support human, animal and plant life.



WHAT CAUSES DROUGHT?

LACK OF RAINFALL

Droughts can occur when there is less rain or snow than would normally be expected for that area.

SURFACE WATER FLOW

EXAMPLE EFFECTS OF DROUGHTS

DIRECT EFFECT: Low crop yield leaves farmers with very little produce to sell. This has a huge financial impact on the farmers and their families.

INDIRECT EFFECT: With the farmers having been impacted financially, the sale of materials such as seed, tractors and other farm equipment is reduced. These business and the people who work for them are then financially effected.

OTHER INDIRECT EFFECTS

- Dust bowls, themselves a sign of erosion, which further erode the landscape.

Drought can also reduce water quality, because lower water flows reduce dilution of pollutants and increase contamination of remaining water sources.

LAVA FIZZ

Lava Jamps Jook super cool, but they can be expensive and hard to find. With this activity, you can make your own bubbly lava and learn a bit about oil and water!

YOU WILL NEED

- Water

WHAT TO DO

- 1. Put a few centimetres of water in the bottom of a glass.
- 2. Add a few drops of food colouring to the water and stir
- 3. Add vegetable oil to the glass until it's a few centimetres from the top
- 4. Wait a minute or two for the water and oil layers to separate.
- 5. Drop an effervescent tablet into the glass. and watch as the water bubbles and floats!

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

Water and oil seem pretty similar at first glance. They're both liquids, they're both see-through, and a litre of each weighs about a kilogram. So why don't they mix?

Chemically, oil and water are very different. Water molecules are a type of polar molecule. Polar molecules have a positively charged end and a negatively charged end. Oil molecules do not have charged ends - which makes oil a non-polar liquid

to non-polar, which explains why oil and water don't really mix well. Instead they separate out into layers. Water is a bit denser than vegetable oil, so the water settles to the bottom, and the oil floats on ton

Effervescent tablets react differently to oil and water. The fizzing bicarbonate. These two substances are stable when they are solids, and they don't do much in oil either.

But charged water molecules will rip citric acid and sodium bicarbonate apart. Floating freely, the acid reacts with the bicarbonate to produce liquid water and carbon dioxide gas.

by a layer of water. As they float up, they drag that water with them. Eventually, the bubble makes it to the surface and pops. The water is no longer buoyed by a gas bubble, so it sinks back down to the bottom of the glass creating a lava lamp effect.







BLUE: The Indian Ocean surrounding the island



RECREATING THE GREENHOUSE EFFECT

The Earth's climate has changed many times in the past. Subtropical forests have spread from the south into more temperate or milder, cooler climates areas. Millions of years later, ice sheets spread from the north covering much of the northern United States, Europe and Asia with great glaciers. Today, early all scientists believe human beings are changing the climate. How can that be?

Over the past few centuries, people have been burning more amounts of fuels such as wood, coal, oil, natural gas and gasoline. The gases formed by the burning, such as carbon dioxide, are building up in the atmosphere. They act like greenhouse glass. The result, many experts believe, is that the Earth is heating up and undergoing global warming.



HOW CAN YOU SHOW THE GREENHOUSE EFFECT?

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Two identical glass jars
 4 cups cold water
- 10 ice cubes
- One clear plastic t
 Thermometer

WHAT TO DO

- 1. Take two identical glass jars each containing 2 cups of cold water.
- 2. Add 5 ice cubes to each
- Wrap one in a plastic bag (this is the greenhouse glass).
- Leave both jars in the sun for one hour
 Measure the temperature of the water in each jar.

WHAT YOU'LL DISCOVER!

In bright sunshine, the air inside a greenhouse becomes warm. The greenhouse glass lets in the sun's light energy and some of its heat energy. This heat builds up inside the greenhouse. You have just shown a small greenhouse effect. What do you think could happen it his greenhouse effect changed the Earth's climate?

Another version of a greenhouse is what happens inside an automobile parked in the sun. The sun's light and heat gets into the vehicle and is trapped inside, like the plastic bag around the jar. The temperature inside a car can get over 49 degrees Celsius.



THE IMPORTANCE OF ROAD SAFETY:

Whether you're walking to school, cycling or playing with your scooter, it's important to know of the road rules to keep you safe at all times. As we head into summer, more and more of you will be outside and with that comes potential dangers that you need to be aware of Here are Just Kidding's top liys to keep you having fun but staying safe at all times:



Always look for signals and use pedestrian crossings to cross the road. In the absence of markings remember:

- Look right, then left to see if there are any vehicles approaching. Never chance crossing the road unless you are absolutely sure it is safe.
- Never cross at bends or when you have anything that obstructs your vision.
- · Never cross between stationery vehicles.
- Listen carefully. When crossing, do not wear headphones.

should also wear protective gear such as
knee and elbow pads.

 Always check your equipment before you ride. Are your wheels pumped up to the correct pressures? Are your brakes working correctly and are your handlebars tight and secure? Checking your bike or scooter before you ride takes just 5 minutes but could save you from a nasty fall or accident.





 Always use a light in areas of poor visibility. Motorists and other fellow road users need to see you!

> If using a scooter, avoid gravel and sandy surfaces as well as drainage grates and bumpy roads. Scooters are great fun but they don't operate like a bike.

> > Replace old or damaged equipment and try to wear bright coloured clothing to make you stand out on the road.

DROPPING IN

STEP 1: Place your scooter deck on the edge of the ramp (bank or quarter) so it is flat on the coping.

STEP 2: Make sure your body weight is directly on top of the scooter or your deck will slip on the coping!

STEP 3: As soon as you feel confident or stable enough, start to lean forward directly over your handle bars (but not so much that you front flip). Just as your front wheel is about to touch the ramp, start leaning back a bit to level yourself out.

STEP 4: Roll away and have fun!



FEEBLE GRIND

STEP 1: Approach ledge with a comfortable amount of speed. You should be almost, parallel with the ledge as you hop onto it.

STEP 2: Now that you're in the feeble grind.

maintain a stable riding position while leaning
over the bars a little. Push your back wheel
into the edge of the ledge and remember to
keep the front wheel parallel with the coping
(piece of metal on edge of ramp).

STEP 3: Maintain pressure on the back wheel and keep that front wheel pointed in the direction that you want to go.

STEP 4: As you approach the end of the ledge, shift your body weight back towards the centre of the deck and start to bend your knees in preparation to hop off the ledge.





TAIL WHIP

STEP 1: Roll up to the ramp with the same speed you'd tackle a bunny hop with.

STEP 2: Load up a big hop.

STEP 3: As you're begging your bunny hop, push or flick your deck around with your front foot to initiate the tail whip. The amount of air you have will determine how hard you have to push the deck around.

STEP 4: As the tail whip makes its way back around, use your back foot this time to try and catch the deck. Once your back foot is securely on the deck, now all you have to do is put your other foot on and you've successfully landed a tail whip.






BOWLING PINS

WHAT YOU NEED

- Plastic bottles (as many as you want as long as there the same size, these will be your pins)
- Different coloured ribbon Coloured paper
- Tape Coloured Markers
- Scissors Fabric · Sand or dirt
- Cardboard A tennis ball • Wool





INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Make sure that all your plastic bottles are empty and dry.
- 2. Tape a coloured piece of paper around each of the bottles.
- (Ontional) Draw faces and decorate them with the coloured markers
- 4. Once you have finished decorating them, fill each bottle a third or less of the way with sand or dirt, to weigh them down. Make sure you cover the top with the lid or with sticky tape to stop the sand/dirt coming out when the pins are knocked over.
- 5. Now your bowling pins are ready to be bowled over. Putting more weight in to the pins makes them harder to knock down, so to make the game harder and more interesting you can add more sand to make them heavier. You will then use the tennis ball as your bowling ball and now you are ready to go!

INDOOR PAPER BASKETBALL

WHAT YOU NEED

- · A milk/juice carton cut in half (discard the end with the opening and keep the bottom half) or a medium sized box
- · A large square piece of cardboard for the backboard
- · Masking tape Scissors
- Paint and paintbrushes
 Scrap paper/newspaper

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut the milk or juice container in half, keeping the bottom half.
- 2. Decorate the container with paint and anything else you want to cover it in. You will then need to set it aside to dry
- 3. Tape one side of the decorated container to the cardboard, placing it near the bottom of the cardboard, this will be your basket. Draw a square box on the card board above where the container is placed. This should look like the small square you see above the ring on proper basketball rings.
- 4. Next, hang it somewhere like on a chair or a door, or rest it against a table or shelf.
- 5. Scrunch up scrap paper to make small basketballs. If you find your paper balls keep falling apart then get a bit of sticky tape and wrap it around the ball so that it stays tightly scrunched.
- 6. To play, throw the paper basketballs through the top opening of the basket. When you play with others, see who can score the most points. To make it harder step backwards so that you have to throw from further away.
